Start Up Procedures for Pools & Spas

Like most things in life - the better you start the easier things go. That is why we want you to follow these simple steps. Should you have any doubts or concerns, please feel welcome to contact our team on 1800 648 959.

STEP 1 **HEAT AND READ**
(DETERMINING WHAT CHEMICALS NEED TO BE ADDED)

Preheat water in spa to at least 26 degrees then, using the POPPIT SANOSIL Test strip (swirl 3 times and line up with colour indicators on test vial) check and record pH and alkalinity. It is important to make the reading within 30 seconds for it to be accurate.

STEP 2 **BALANCE WATER**
(ADJUSTING THE PH & TOTAL ALKALINITY WITH POPPIT ONE-STEP WATER PREP)

Based on the reading on the strip you can determine how much of the POPPIT ONE STEP WATER PREP to add. See the chart below for how much to add. When adding Poppits One-Step Water Prep to spa water, pour it slowly into the spa with the jets turned off.

pH	Alkalinity	ADD	Per 1000lt	1500lt	3000lt	5000lt
LOW	0-20ppm	>	1000ml	1500ml	3000ml	5000ml
LOW	21-40ppm	>	650ml	975ml	1950ml	3250ml
6.5	41-60ppm	>	400ml	600ml	1200ml	2000ml

Circulate water for 2 - 3 hours before moving to Step 3.
NOTE: Generally town water supply has some level of alkalinity whereas rain water (tank water) has none. Check levels again next day (please note, the strips read pH slightly lower than actual and so if reading for pH is at the lower end of the scale this is acceptable).

STEP 3 **SANITISE YOUR SPA**
(ADDING POPPIT SANOSIL POOL & SPA SANITISER)

For Spas up to 3000 litres add 300ml/1000 litres and circulate for 30 minutes. For Swim Spas add 200ml/1000 litres and circulate for 60 minutes.

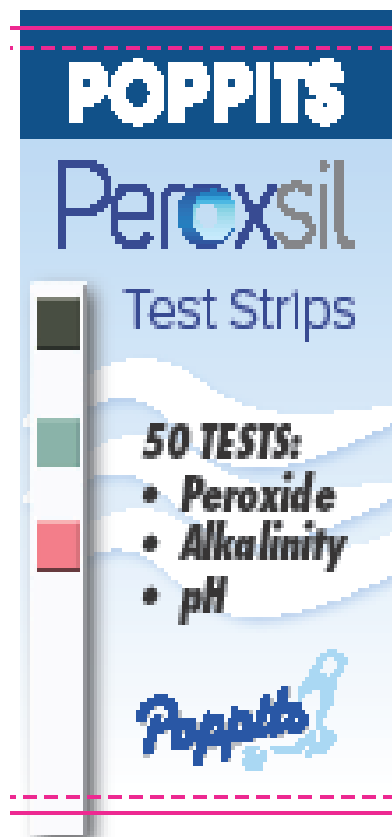

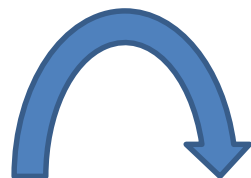

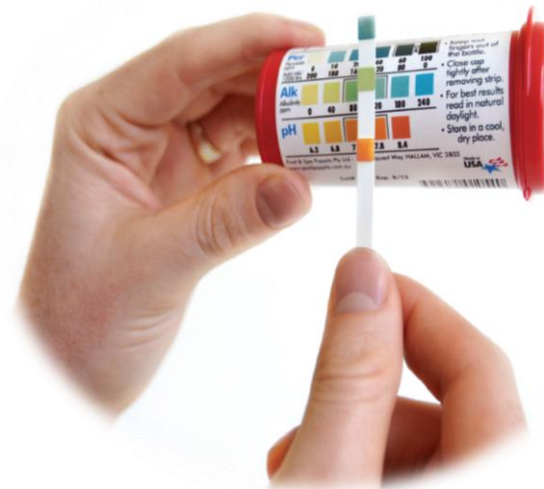

Spa & Swim Spa Water Maintenance

Care for your Spa and for the environment

It stands to reason that - the better you maintain the water, the longer the water will remain "fit for use" and, the less often the water will need to be drained and replaced.

Peroxil³⁹⁵ has been designed to save water, save time, save money and save your sanity!

We recommend that your maintenance program include a simple routine check on the key areas of water management.

- 1. Water Balance**
Check at least once a week that the pH is 7 - 7.5; and alkalinity 60 - 120. If you have used Poppit One Step Water Prep you will find that the balance will remain constant for the life of this water in the spa.
- 2. Sanitizer Level**
Weekly and before use, ensure that Peroxil³⁹⁵ reading on the strip (Sanitizer) is 1.00ppm. If not adjust by adding the recommended dose as per the Test Strip label for the level you read. This will restore the level. Fitting an auto doser will make this more convenient for you. Ask your local stockist.
- 3. Visual**
If the water looks good and there is no odour, it is probably going to be fine. If cloudy, you may want to add Poppit Quick Fix Odouriser at the rate of 30 grams/1000 litres. You should only need to do this every 2 weeks. Make sure when adding Poppit Quick Fix the cover is fully off the Spa, and filter for 30 minutes.
- 4. Phosphate & Algae Control**
If you find that you are using more than 120 ml/1000 ml of Peroxil³⁹⁵ per week (and you haven't had exceptionally high use or a party) then it is likely that phosphate or algae (or both) have come into the spa.

Add 100mls on a weekly basis or what's indicated on the Peroxsil Test strip.





Fortnightly.



FILTER CARTRIDGE CLEANING

Poppit Filter Cartridge Cleaner

Fill laundry tub with hot water **15 liters**,
add **50 gms**, and soak filters for 4 hours.

Rinse off thoroughly and allow to dry
before returning the filters to the spa





Fortnightly.



VISUAL *Poppit Quick Fix*

If the water looks good and there is no odour, it is probably going to be fine, but to keep water sparkling also if cloudy, you may be required to

Add **30 gms** per **1000 Litres** on a **fortnightly** basis or after heavy use

****Ensure cover is off spa, and filter for 30 minutes**





Monthly.



PHOSPHATE & ALGAE CONTROL

Poppit Pool & Spa Complete Maintenance

Add **50 mls** per **1000 Litres** on a monthly basis

****** Also use to wipe underside of spa cover monthly, using damp cloth to prevent algae build up





Every 3 to 4 Months.



SPA PIPE DEGREASING

Poppit Spa Pipe Degreaser

Add **50 mls** per **1000 Litres** remove filters and pulsate through the Spa for 30 minutes or longer if required

Also use to wipe underside of spa cover and head rests using damp cloth

**** Follow directions carefully on container**
